Student view



Functions of the students homepage:

1. Module that the student has purchased or the teacher has assigned to him/her.
2. Prodiags shop advertisement, by clicking on the image you can go to the shop and view the learning modules. Only visible in self-study, usually hidden in organisational use.
3. User learning progress display. Prodiags informs the user which module he has to improve the most.
4. The student can have multiple learning modules. Prodiags separates them automatically in different groups so that they are easier to view and use.
5. The student has direct access to his / her own study register, where he / she can see how the tasks have gone.
6. Log out button


The students study register has these following functions:

1. The student can search results from different learning modules independently.
2. Learning module tasks combined result: green = excellent, yellow = pass, red = fail.
3. Log, where user can see when the learning module task was last viewed.
4. Best results of the tasks.
5. Here the student can observe his/her learning progress and view which answers went correct and which went wrong.
6. If the user passed a task, the user can print a certificate for example to his/her CV. All learning modules doesn't include certificates.
